

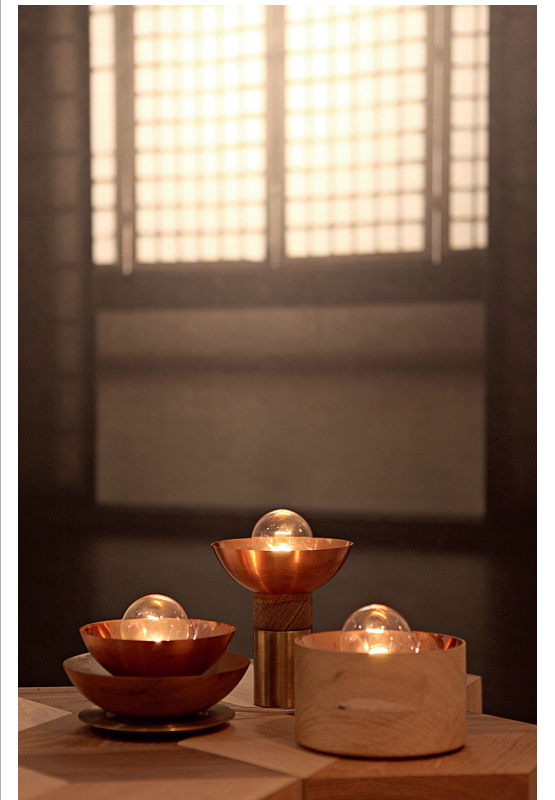
## Inspired ideas
